Called to Order: Scott Kimble called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm and led the group in prayer.

Approval of the Minutes: The minutes from the February meeting were approved as submitted with the following correction in the Pastor's Remarks: delete sentence beginning "The St. Joe's parish family" and replace it with "As of this time there is no evidence of any victims here." Kathy Wright made the motion, with Nancy Delac seconding it.

Commission Report: No commission reports for August 2020.

Commission Reports from Liaisons:

Skip due to COVID slowdown, no reports.

Followup from February meeting: No comments on this subject.

Discuss COVID ongoing plan & Pastor' Remarks: During the shut-down there was no mention of shutting down any religious organizations and as of this date there have been no outbreaks within them. So far we are at only 30% mass attendance. It was only in the early in the 1900's that communion was offered more often. Tom commented on the mass offered on line in place of in person. The masks are required at mass attended in person and social distancing is required. (there have been no incidents of the virus being spread within the mass attendees. Saint Joseph and John School will open the day after Labor Day and temperatures will be taken and masks required. The principals of the private schools have been in meetings during the entire summer. The views of the 10:00 am Sunday mass started at 212 and ended at over 500. Should we recruit more parishioners back to mass? A discussion followed re the combining of 10:00 and noon mass. Four thirty on Saturday and 8:00 AM masses will remain the same. A survey of parishioners is a possibility. The present mass schedule has been effective since 2008. A discussion of Faith Direct donations followed. The parish as well as the school applied for the payroll protection plan (\$132,000 for the church and \$460,000 for the school) An anonymous donor donated \$50,000 and paid for the new kneelers in the church (\$35,000) and carpeting to be installed soon in the HF center, meeting rooms and office (\$15,000). Father Joe then gave a short report on his health: He was diagnosed with a cancer common to transplant patients. He followed a series of five days' treatment and two off for 13 weeks and his last one will be week ending August 31. He is dealing with mouth sores but is very grateful for all the cards and prayers.

Open Forum: Mike Kelly will be relocating so will be unable to take over the chair position at Parish Council. The council members will be considered for the position are Thomas Uthup, Matt Totorigi and Nancy Delac.

Closing Prayer: Scott led the group in Closing Prayer and the Our Father. He then adjourned the meeting at 8:19 pm. The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 12.
